Professor Robert Gibson is Consultant Radiologist at the Royal Melbourne Hospital and Professorial Fellow at The University of Melbourne.

He was Professor in the University Department of Radiology for ten years, and led undergraduate & postgraduate teaching in radiology in that time. His main clinical and research interests currently are in abdominal ultrasound, in particular contrast ultrasound and elastography.

He is an Honorary Fellow of ASUM having been the ASUM Secretary and was the foundation editor of what is now the Australasian Journal of Ultrasound in Medicine. He was a foundation executive member of the Abdominal Radiological Group of Australia and New Zealand, is a Corresponding Fellow of the

European Society of Gastrointestinal and Abdominal Radiology and has been the recipient of the Clinical Radiology Educational Service Award of the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Radiologists.

He has served on the Editorial Board of several international journals as well as on multiple professional and government committees. He has published over 150 scientific papers, edited two books and written 25 chapters in his field.
