

Purpose of Cranial Logbook.

- Document completion of scanning requirements
- Record interactions between candidate and supervisor.
- Demonstrate a progression from beginner to competent CCPU scanner.

To fulfil the above logbooks need to be completed contemporaneously and reviewed by supervisor as near to the scan as possible. For early scans this will usually be at the time of scanning for more advanced candidates should be within 48 hours.

The Logbook should be in addition to any internal reporting mechanisms that may exist.
